Budget Updates

- Committee members were provided with copies of the FFY19 FFY22 budgets in the meeting packet.
 - o FFY19 Grant End Date: Dec 31, 2022 MAPC is working on closeout.
 - o FFY20 Grant End Date: June 30, 2023
 - o FFY21 Grant End Date: July 31, 2023
 - o FFY22 Grant End Date: July 31, 2024

Project Updates

- Regional Stop-the-Bleed Training
 - There have been 10 Stop-the-Bleed classes held at various locations in the Merrimac and Groveland region and 137 participants have been trained. At least 100 additional first responders have used the training equipment for scenarios and drills. Their next scheduled class will be at the Merrimac FD on January 17th.
- Nero's Law Trainings
 - The PJ was approved by EOPSS but the project was put on hold pending further guidance from J. Brickett to ensure that the equipment is necessary and the right type to adhere to the training curriculum requirements.
- Active Shooter (ASHER) Trainings and Exercises
 - O Three active shooter projects were approved the November meeting:
 - Acton/Littleton/Groton
 - Hudson/Maynard/Stow
 - AAIR Course

- Police and Fire leadership from involved communities met on December 12th to discuss collaboration and determined it would be most efficient and effective to pool the funding to conduct as many AAIR Courses as possible for those communities.
- The pooled funding would support approximately 4 AAIR Courses for 150-200 attendees, giving priority to the 6 original communities and opening any remaining spots to others in the region.

- Re-allocate the total \$130,580 previously allocated to these three separate projects to support AAIR courses for as many participants as possible from the 6 requesting towns.
