Call to Order

Budget Updates

- Committee members were provided with copies of the FFY19, FFY20, and FFY21 budgets in the meeting packet. The FFY22 budget excel document is being finalized.
 - o FFY19 Grant End Date: Dec 31, 2022
 - o FFY20 Grant End Date: June 30, 2023
 - o FFY21 Grant End Date: July 31, 2023
 - o FFY22 Grant End Date: July 31, 2024
 - Total of \$225,560 for T&E (Tech Rescue, Incident Command, and Active Shooter Trainings).

Project Updates

- Regional Stop-the-Bleed Training
 - Trainings will be scheduled into the new year. Sgt. Holcroft will be sending a report for the January Committee meeting of how many training courses occurred, locations, and the remaining upcoming classes. The project will conclude by March 31st, 2023.
- Nero's Law Trainings
 - The PJ has been approved by EOPSS. We are waiting to receive further details from J. Brickett before conducting a joint procurement with the other regions.
- Active Shooter (ASHER) Trainings and Exercises
 - Three active shooter projects were approved at last month's meeting:
 - Acton/Littleton/Groton
 - Hudson/Maynard/Stow
 - AAIR Course
 - o Project leads are discussing potential collaboration opportunities to make the most of the available funding, and a meeting will be held on December 12th to continue this



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- discussion with fire/police leadership from all involved communities and Sgt. Holcroft to represent AAIR.
- Project leads expressed concerns regarding the \$35/hr BF/OT cap and asked if they could be allowed to spend the amount allocated at their discretion in the way that would be most advantageous to their departments.
- o The Committee discussed the cap, and the official policy remains in place at this time.

Technical Rescue Teams

 - The Committee discussed GIS and GPS systems, and the need for a wider conversation regarding NERAC buying into a single system.

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 V. Mboka-Boyer instructed that EOPSS is requiring Technical Rescue Teams to include briefings on radio communications in AARs, and communications elements should be included in Tech Rescue drills.
