 - Modular Shields The PJ has been approved by EOPSS and MAPC is working on specifications for procurement.
 - o *Mobile Ballistic Shields* The PJ has been approved by EOPSS and MAPC is working on specifications for procurement.
 - LRAD Voice Broadcast System The PJ has been approved by EOPSS and MAPC is in touch with Lt. Fay of Lowell to finalize specifications. This item was the priority of the 3 projects so that procurement will be conducted first.
- Merrimack Valley Camera System Expansion
 - MAPC is in touch with our new contacts at Lawrence PD (Lt. Rogers and Deputy Chief McCarthy) to finalize specifications. We met with them to discuss and sent some followup questions that we are waiting to hear back on.
- NERAC Ambubus
 - The Council voted at the last meeting to look into whether the Ambubus could become a hospital asset through HPP funding. We are still waiting to hear back from our contacts.

- The PJ was approved by EOPSS. We are working with Ed and Colby to draft the scope of work for the project.
- Cybersecurity Internship
 - The PJ was approved by EOPSS and MAPC is drafting an MOU with the Town of Danvers.
 - The internship opportunity was posted last Friday, and we have already received 22 applications. We are putting together an interview committee and expect the process to begin in the coming weeks.

EOPSS would like to reinvigorate a statewide exercise program bringing together each region, utilizing state share and 3% allocated by each region for HSEEP exercises.
