Call to Order

Budget Updates

- FY21 Grant End Date: June 30, 2025
- FY22 Grant End Date: July 31, 2025
- FY23 Grant End Date: July 31, 2025
- FY24 Grant End Date: June 30, 2026
 - NERAC/MAPC now has access to FY24 funding.
 - Grants with earlier deadlines should be prioritized, but critical FY24 projects they can be expedited.

Project Updates

- ECFCA UHF Receivers
 - MAPC submitted the revised PJ/ICIP to EOPSS for the November SIEC meeting, and there were some follow-up questions.
 - MAPC will consult with T. Dechene to discuss and submit a revised ICIP.
- ECFCA Wide Area Network VHF Consolette Radios
 - MAPC is reviewing draft specifications sent by C. Ryan.
 - Feedback and questions will be sent to C. Ryan, D. Spinosa, T. Dechene, and J. Collins-Brown.
- Field Comm Units 20 & 60 Upgrades
 - The RFQ for installation was sent to several vendors, but no quotes were received.



- A letter sent from one vendor noted some concerns with the scope of work.
- D. Spinosa will assist with modifying the scope based on their feedback, and when the revised RFQ is sent it will include additional vendors as recommended.
- FD-5/15 Mobile Gateway Radios and Recorders
 - NERAC's portion of this project is complete.
 - On agenda to track install progress (not NERAC funded).
- FD-6 MW Groton to Westford
 - Enclosed Cabinet Funding Request
 - The remaining Motorola items that were delayed arrived, so the final components can now be installed.
 - Due to a rodent issue at the install site, CyberComm and M. Svatek determined that an enclosed cabinet will be required instead of an open one.
 - A quote for for \$906 was included in the meeting packet, p.7.

- Allocate funds not to exceed \$2,000 from FFY22 H.02 for the purchase of an enclose cabinet with dimensions to be determined by M. Svatek.

 - Questions on locations and equipment needed are with T. Dechene to finalize specifications for procurement.
 - Metrofire North District Radio Common Platform
 - D. Frizzell is awaiting information on equipment needs from Metrofire.
 - NERAC Radio Programming Initiative
 - Survey Results
 - The meeting packet contained responses to the survey that was sent out to all NERAC police chiefs, fire chiefs, and town administrators.
 - Overall there was interest in the project as proposed.
 - A draft of Survey: Part 2 was included in the meeting packet and revisions were discussed.

School Radio Best Practices

- The previously reviewed flyer and newly drafted detailed companion document were included in the meeting packet.
- The drafts will be sent to SWIC R. Fiske for input from EOPSS/SIEC before finalizing and formatting.



State Interoperability Executive Committee (SIEC) Updates

- SIEC did not meet in December.
- There was a virtual meeting to discuss MIFOG updates a few weeks ago, and draft revisions will be released.

New Business Unforeseen by the Chair

- J. Targ is retiring and suggests M. Svatek as his replacement on the Committee to represent Fire District 6. This will require a vote of the Full Council.
- MAPC hired Karla Kahale for the open Program Specialist position. K. Kahale will be starting in January and working on NERAC and the Shannon Grant Community Safety Initiative.
- The ECFCA and ECCOPA radio caches were used extensively during the brushfires and the ECCOPA. ECFCA will be replacing some batteries as needed.
