#### • Budget Updates

- Committee members were provided with copies of the FFY20 FFY23 budgets in the meeting packet.
  - FFY20 Grant End Date: June 30, 2024
    - MAPC expects to be able to close out FFY20 shortly with some invoices that came in and the Council's previous vote allowing transfers of even swaps for closeout.
  - FFY21 Grant End Date: June 30, 2024
  - FFY22 Grant End Date: July 31, 2024
  - FFY23 Grant End Date: July 31, 2025

#### • Project Updates

- o AAIR Trainings
  - On March 11<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> a session of the AAIR training was held at Middlesex Community College in Bedford. Thank you to Chief J. Fisher for helping to arrange that.
  - 32 students: 15 Police, 13 Fire & 4 Dispatchers, from 20 NERAC communities.
  - Student Feedback: Nearly every student rated all 5s/4s on the feedback survey. Common themes:
    - Consistent high praise for instructors.
    - They valued the multi-disciplinary experience.
    - Those that have been to other trainings said this was among the best.
    - The main suggestion/negative feedback was they wish it was more than 2 days long.



- The next session that was planned for March 27<sup>th</sup> 28<sup>th</sup> will need to be postponed, but we are working arrange new upcoming dates at the same location.
- o School Safety Seminar
  - MAPC met with NERAC's public school reps S. Morrison and S. Zrike to brainstorm.
    - The proposed timeframe is ½ day in September/October 2024 possibly the first week of October and avoiding Monday and Friday.
    - Topics to address: Swatting, Threat Assessment, MCI Preparedness and Incident Command (for if/when prevention doesn't work), Considerations and plans for Incident Command, Communications with parents and outside parties, After-School Violence, Ensuring planning takes into account individuals with disabilities.
  - MAPC is now looking for a venue that is more central to the NERAC region, and requests suggestions or connections Council members may have.
  - Once a venue/date is confirmed, the next step will be securing presenters.
- o Topsfield Fair MCI Functional Exercise
  - The kick-off meeting occurred on February 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - The project facilitators reviewed the 2019 TTX AAR which this FE will build upon, and had preliminary discussion on goals and objectives.
  - The next planning meeting is scheduled for April 4<sup>th</sup>.
  - Interoperability and unified command will be the primary focus.
