• Budget Updates

- FFY20 Grant End Date: June 30, 2024
 - MAPC is finalizing line items to close out.
- MAPC is requesting an extension from EOPSS until June 30, 2025 for:
 - FFY21 Current Grant End Date: June 30, 2024
 - FFY22 Current Grant End Date: July 31, 2024
- FFY23 Grant End Date: July 31, 2025

• Project Updates

- AAIR Trainings
 - MAPC has not heard back from Middlesex Community College regarding any dates available before the end of May, when they will be demolishing the building that was used for the practical scenarios.
 - A new site would likely need a new EHP review and instructor planning meeting.
 - April is too tight for necessary approvals, advertising and registration process.
 - Instructors' May and June schedules are fully booked.
 - MAPC will look into July or August dates.
 - Schools are the ideal setup and won't be in session.
 - S. Malloy sent us a contact for two vacant schools in Woburn.
- School Safety Seminar
 - MAPC is researching venues central to the region.



- Ex: schools and colleges, conference centers/hotels, community centers, event spaces.
- Auditorium style worked well last time
- Suggestions for free/inexpensive, central spaces for 150+ are welcome!
- Tentative date of Thursday, Oct 3rd.
- After determining venue availability, MAPC will reach out to potential speakers.
- Topsfield Fair MCI Functional Exercise
 - The mid-term planning meeting was April 4th in Topsfield.
 - The scenario, objectives, and exercise parameters were discussed.
 - The 2 main categories of objectives to evaluate are communications and unified command.
 - Final Planning Meeting Wednesday, May 29th
 - Exercise Thursday, June 6th
 - Approximately 42 role players will be available from State Police cadets and other organizations.

• FY24 Plan Development

- The Council put together a preliminary budget at the March meeting.
- It includes the A- and B- List funding for T&E projects as suggested by this Committee.
- EOPSS provided the following updates:

FY24 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP) Updates

- Retain the overall minimum spend requirement of 30% across all six National Priority Areas (NPAs)
- Retain the 3% minimum spend for the Election Security NPA
- Remove the minimum spends for the remaining five NPAs:
 - Enhancing the Protection of Soft Targets and Crowded Places
 - Enhancing Intelligence and Information Sharing and Analysis
 Compating Demostic Violent Extremism
 - Combating Domestic Violent Extremism
 Enhancing Community Preparedness and Resilie
 - Enhancing Community Preparedness and Resilience
 Enhancing Cybersecurity
- Retain the minimum 35% for Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Activities (LETPA)
