- FY21 FY24 budgets were provided in the meeting packet.
- FY21-23 grants end June / July 2025
 - As projects are completed MAPC will look options to pay invoices out of earlier grant years for spend down.
 - In February, NERAC Full Council will be doing a budget deep dive.
- FY24 grant ends June 2026

Project Updates

- ECFCA UHF Receivers
 - Submitted a revised ICIP for this project for December SIEC but SWIC/EOPSS had some questions.
 - After frequency coordination was completed, a portion of the project didn't fit into the original name/scope.
 - T. Dechene will send further details for MAPC to submit to EOPSS/SIEC.
- ECFCA Wide Area Network VHF Consolette Radios
 - Specifications are under review at MAPC.
- Field Comm Units 20 & 60 Upgrades
 - Vendors had concerns about the feasibility of original installation scope.
 - The Committee discussed that the scope can be amended to allow work to be done at the vendor's shop site.
 - D. Spinosa will provide further guidance after reviewing scope.
- FD-5/15 Mobile Gateway Radios and Recorders
 - NERAC's portion of this project is complete.
 - On agenda to track install (not NERAC funded) which is in progress by T.
 Dechene.
- FD-6 MW Groton to Westford
 - In December, the Committee voted to reserve up to \$2,000 for an enclosed cabinet, size to be determined by M. Svatek.
 - A quote for \$1,250 for a 60"x22"x24" cabinet was included in the meeting packet, but M. Svatek will look into whether there is a larger option available.
- GBPC Microwave Routers and Switches
 - Spoke with T. Dechene after the last meeting for some info.
 - Remaining info needed is make/model for the SPF transceivers, quantity of Y-Cable Kits, and list of locations to be installed.
- Metrofire North District Radio Common Platform
 - D. Frizzell provided an update that cost will be higher than expected.

- NERAC's EOPSS Program Coordinator is aware that we will be submitting an urgent PJ for approval, and the SWIC confirmed it will not require SIEC approval.
- A drafted PJ and questions to guide conversation were included in the meeting packet.
- C. Ryan provided the following updates:
 - Kenwood has 1.5 day classes for 10-15 for no cost, with availability at the end of February/early March.
 - Motorola classes may have a cost.
